The **free** and **voluntary** offer for Covid-19 vaccination is for pupils from the age of 12 and all those working at the school. This is a service provided by the **Ministry of Health** together with the **Ministry of Education** and in cooperation with the Physicians Association **Kassenärztliche Vereinigung Schleswig-Holstein** (KVSH), the German Red Cross and the Johanniter Unfallhilfe. The vaccination campaign **is therefore not a school event**.

1. Registration

- All those wishing to take advantage of the vaccination offer must register in advance. It is not possible to be vaccinated spontaneously without an appointment.
- Children under the age of 14 need the consent of a parent or guardian.
- Children between 14 and 17 may fill out and sign the documents themselves. (Parents may also sign the documents in consultation with their child).
- Even if you have already registered, you can decide at any time not to accept the vaccination offer.
- Registration must be made by August 6, 2021 latest, and handed over in a sealed envelope to the class teacher or to
 the school secretariate office.
- The school will forward the registration to the KVSH.

2. Appointments

- Between August 19 and September 30, two vaccinations will be given in intervals of three weeks.
- The vaccination appointments will be offered on mornings and afternoons and if necessary, also on weekends.
- The school will be informed about the exact date of the vaccination by the Kassenärztliche Vereinigung Schleswig-Holstein with approximately one week's notice.
- Please bring the vaccination certificate (if available), an identification document as well as filled out and signed information, consent and medical history forms to your vaccination appointment.

3. Vaccination

- The mobile vaccination teams each consist of two physicians and three assistants.
- Vaccination is an **individual decision** in which the arguments in favour and against are weighed up, if necessary, together with your physician.
- Parents may accompany their child to the vaccination appointment. Current rules for entering the school (e.g. compulsory testing) must be observed.
- Only the vaccine approved for children and adolescents of 12 years of age and older, Comirnaty® from Biontech/Pfizer, will be used.
